## **Description:**

Are you interested in helping visitors to Cylburn Arboretum feel welcome? Do you love helping people learn? Are you looking for a regular volunteer opportunity that does not change based on season? We would love to have you as a Visitor Service Volunteer!

As a VSV, you will welcome the public and answer questions. You will be trained to greet and engage visitors, ensuring a rewarding experience for all guests. You will be expected to relate to people of all ages and backgrounds.

The ideal candidate will work at least one four-hour shift per week, with a minimum of one shift per month each in the Vollmer Welcome Center and the Nature Education Center. The VSV would be expected to perform tasks with a great deal of independence.

## **Typical Duties:**

- Welcome all guests as the "face" of Cylburn and the first encounter guests experience
- Restock handout inventory
- Offer a brief, clear explanation of Cylburn Arboretum and its facilities, including the Nature Education Center
- Answer questions and steer guests toward further information that will enhance the learning aspect of their visit
- Help keep the Vollmer Welcome Center or NEC tidy
